2018-2019 Land Trust Plan Summary

Bingham High School had an operating Land Trust budget of \$251,525 for the 2018 – 2019 school year. The following is a summary of the final report. The full final report can be found on the State Land Trust website www.schoollandtrust.org/

Bingham High School used monies allocated to the school to pay for the cost of three full time teachers to reduce class size in the math and science areas. Additional money was used to pay for after school tutoring programs that are focused on math achievement. Sections a computer programming course were funded using these funds also. Finally, ACT preparation courses were offered to students to improve achievement on this assessment.

Bingham High School was able to purchase additional chrome book labs using Land Trust funds. Purchasing these labs helped us to increase technology available to students and begin the process of converting to a digitally based classroom.

Bingham High School was able to use Land Trust funds to support teachers in their continued professional learning. Teachers were able to attend local conferences and also work additional hours during the summer in their PLC groups.
